Saturday, September 24

Get ready to sell! If you've been meaning to clean out your garage, closets, and cupboards there's no better time! The Mira Lagos HOA community-wide fall garage sale is Saturday, September 24, 2022.

The city of Grand Prairie allows two garage sales per residence annually. Residents of Mira Lagos HOA may host their sales only on the spring and fall



dates selected by the HOA. They may be conducted on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday of the selected weekend. Any resident holding a garage sale outside of the designated spring and fall dates is subject to a \$75 fine.

Participating in the community garage sale is as easy as 1, 2, and 3!

- 1. Apply online for a free permit from the City of Grand Prairie at gptx.org.
- 2. Print your permit and adhere to signs you place.
- 3. Get ready to sell! Clear the clutter and make some cash.

You may place up to three (3) signs in the ground to help direct traffic to your address. Garage sale signs will be positioned in common areas by the HOA.

- Please do not post signs to any of our black street poles or lamps.
- Please do remove all your signs when your garage sale

Before making any modifications to the exterior of your home or lot that are not of the original build, approval must be obtained. To have your

project reviewed, submit an Architectural Control Committee or ACC Request Form with supporting documents or drawings to ACCRequests@miralagoshoa.com.

The only change to a lot that can be made without prior ACC approval is replanting in an existing flower bed including changing out seasonal flowers or replacing dead plant material.
