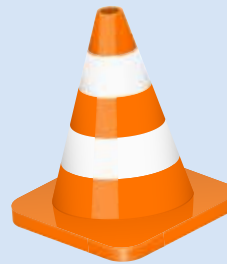

SAFETY TIPS TO STAY COOL IN EXTREME HEAT

We experienced some of the hottest days in history this summer and September isn't much cooler in Texas. Extreme heat is deadly and kills more people than any other weather event. Here's what you can do to stay safe when temperatures reach dangerous highs.

- Stay in an air-conditioned indoor location as much as you can.
- Drink plenty of fluids even if you don't feel thirsty.
- Wear sun protection.
- Schedule outdoor activities carefully.
 - » Wear lightweight, loose-fitting clothing, and sunscreen.
 - » Pace yourself.
- Take cool showers or baths to cool down.
- Check on friends and neighbors and have someone check on you.
- Check the local news for health and safety updates.
- Schedule workouts and practices earlier or later in the day when the temperature is cooler.
- Never leave infants, children, or pets in a parked car, even if the windows are cracked open.
- Visit older adults at risk at least twice a day and closely watch them for signs of heat exhaustion or heat stroke.
- Listen to your body: If the activity starts to feel harder than normal, that's a signal to stop and find a place to cool down.

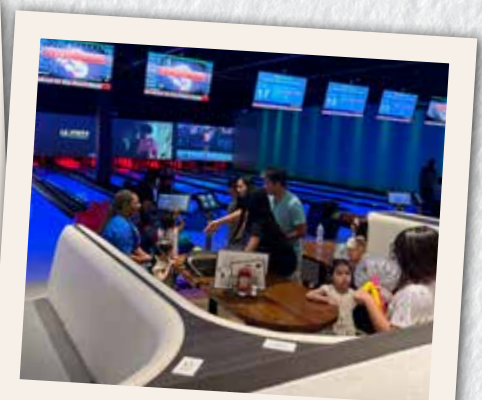
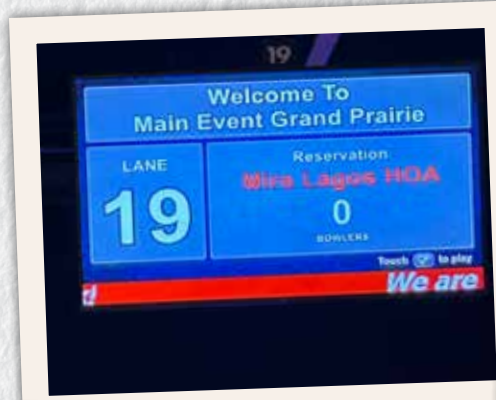
The Mira Lagos Pool and Sports Committee organized three more great summer events!

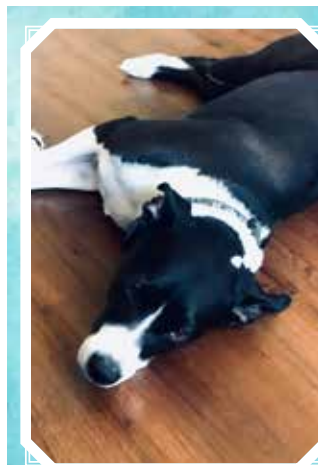
